



SPORTS, ARTS and MĀORI CULTURAL GRANT APPLICATION INFORMATION

Sports, Art and Maori Cultural Grants are intended to support participation in events and activities that have an educational component; and to reduce financial barriers to participation in Sports, Arts and Maori Cultural events and activities.

Eligibility

- a. Registered Owners, descendants and whanau as recognised by Tauhara North No.2 Trust may apply for Sports, Art and Maori Cultural Grants.
- b. Sports, Art and Maori Cultural Grants are allocated to individual participants only (clubs and organisations are ineligible).
- c. Coaches, managers or other support people are not eligible to receive a Sports, Art and Maori Cultural Grant
- d. Sports, Art and Maori Cultural Grants are allocated on the basis that either the activity takes place in New Zealand or the applicant resides in New Zealand.

Grant Value

Sports, Art and Maori Cultural Grants are allocated on the basis of the level of representation the applicant is participating in, for any given event or activity. This means that applicants may apply for a combination of Sport, Art and Maori Cultural grants, up to the value allocated per level of representation.

All eligible individuals are entitled to:

- i. Up to \$200.00 per financial year for CLUB/ SCHOOL level of representation
- ii. Up to \$350.00 per financial year for REGIONAL level of representation
- iii. Up to \$500.00 per financial year for NATIONAL level of representation

The below table sets out an **example** of how the grant can be used

Levels of Representation - Definitions

- CLUBS/SCHOOLS:** Participating in or representing a club/school in events or activities, as an individual or as a member of a local club or school team.
- REGIONAL:** Participating in or representing a District or Region in events or activities, as an individual or as a member of a District or Regional team
- NATIONAL:** Participating in or representing New Zealand in events or activities, as an individual or as a member of a National team.

Application Process

Applications may be submitted at anytime within six months of the event or activity taking place.

- a. Applications will be accepted for costs incurred within the current financial year (1 July – 30 June)
- b. Applicants must provide proof of their participation in the Sport, Art or Maori cultural event or activity.
- c. Applicants must provide proof of the associated costs in their application:
 - I. Applications requesting funds be paid directly to a provider prior to the event/activity must provide quotes or invoices with the application form.
 - II. Applications requesting funds be paid directly to the applicant prior to the event/activity must provide quotes or invoices with the application form.
 - III. Applications for reimbursement of costs already accrued must provide receipts with the application form.
- d. Applications must be made on the Sports, Art and Maori Cultural Grant form.

Payment process

- a. Payment of Sports, Art and Maori Cultural grants can be made in the following ways:
 - I. Direct to a provider following the receipt of a quote or invoice.
 - II. As a reimbursement directly to the applicant's verified New Zealand bank account provided that a receipt be provided to CCL for all expenses claimed.
 - III. Direct to the applicants verified New Zealand bank account provided CCL is satisfied that attached documentation provides sufficient costs.
